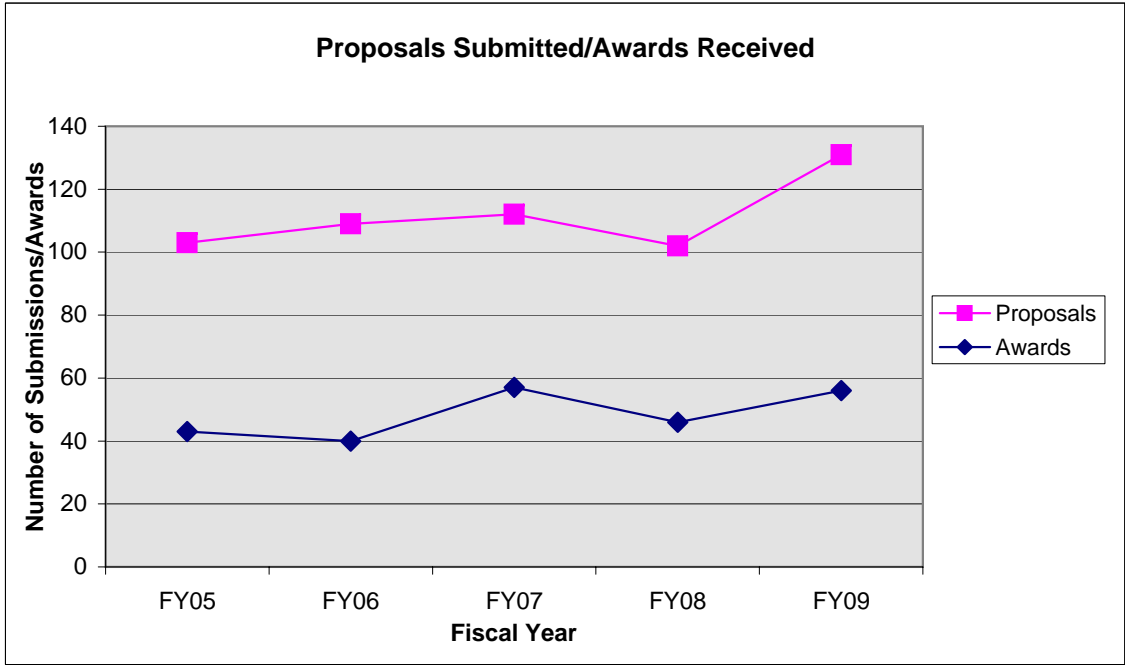

2005 -2009

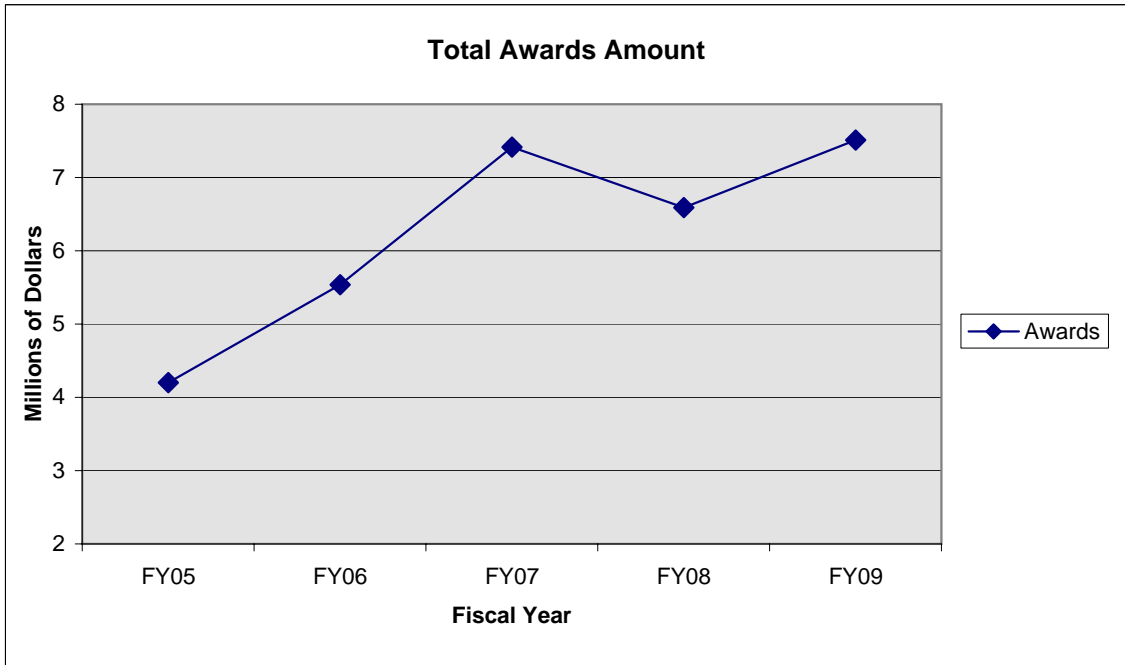
